


Telephone jack requirements




1. Make sure the wall mounting tab is in **DESK** position. Use a coin or small flat tool to rotate it if needed.




- 2. Turn the telephone base over and position it with the power jack and telephone line jack facing towards you.
- 3. Press on the convertible base mount indicated by arrows below to remove it from the telephone base.




4. Plug one end of the coiled cord into the jack on the bottom of the telephone base and the other end into the jack at the bottom of the corded handset.



5. Replace the convertible base mount by aligning the small tabs to the slots in the middle of the telephone base and the larger tabs in the slots near the top as shown...



- 6. Turn the set over and place the handset on the cradle. Plug one end of the telephone line cord into the jack on the back of the telephone base and the other end into a modular jack.
- 7. Plug the smaller end of the power adapter into the jack on the back of the telephone base and the larger end into an electrical outlet not controlled by a wall switch.


